get started now

libertarians are spaced out geographically, so gary recommends calling instead of cold calling/knocking

on the petition, include the four person slate for state committee. any signature you get counts for the state committee

David Fite - campaign finance

8 to 1 matching puts us in reach of winning a city election

sales (campaign t-shirts etc) count as campaign contributions

Dion suggests you find a CPA as your treasurer if you qualify for matching funds. They offer free training, but penalties are big if you do it wrong.
